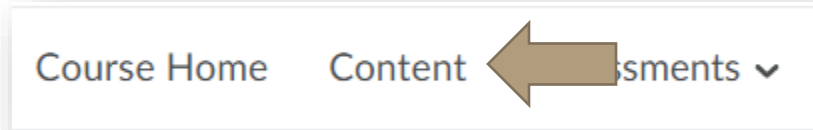


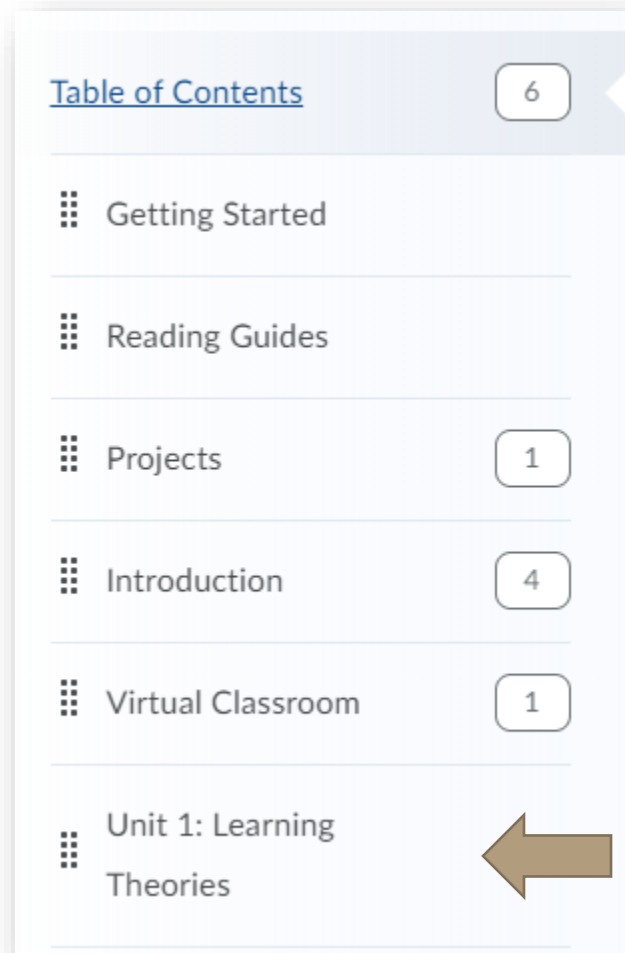
## HOW DO I CREATE A SUBMODULE?

From your course homepage, select “Content” on the navbar.




Choose the module in which you will add your submodules.
