


WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MODULES AND SUBMODULES?

Modules and submodules house all the information and content within your courses.

Modules are the foundational building blocks of your course. They can be organized by date, theme, topic, learning outcome, etc.

Submodules are nested within modules and generally include more specific details and information.
